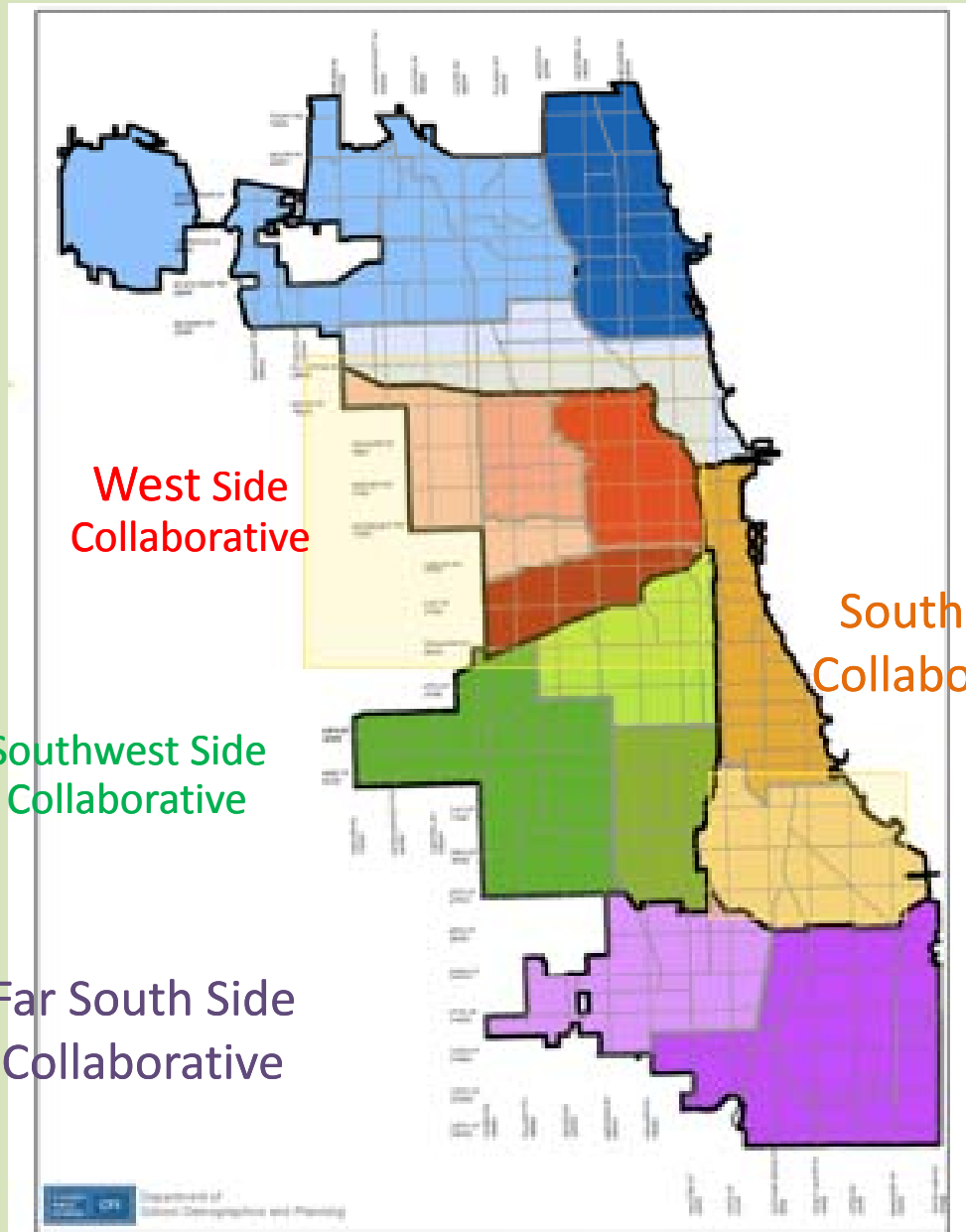

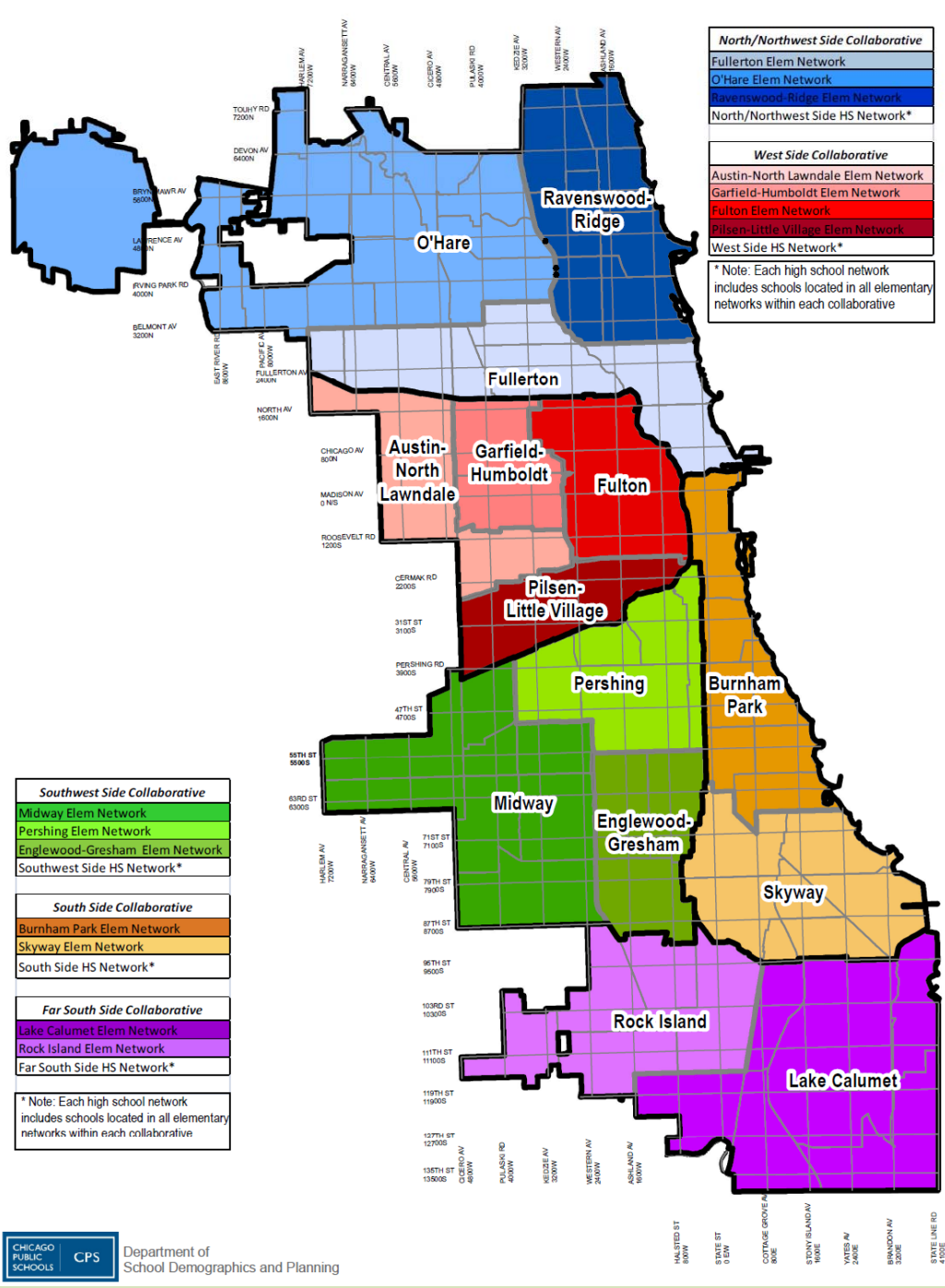

- **Isabel Mesa Collins** has been an educator since 1978, when she began teaching ESL to newcomers to U.S.A. Following her passion, Isabel taught middle school students in the Humboldt Park and Little Village communities for 12 years. This led her to the leadership path when she later worked an Assistant Principal in the Hermosa Park community for 4 years. She then became the Principal of the Drummond Elementary School in 1995 later renamed Drummond Montessori Magnet School where she led until 2007 when she was selected as the Area Instructional Officer and later Chief Area Officer of Area 10 servicing the Pilsen, Little Village, Lawndale, McKinley Park and Brighton Park communities.

# Charge for the Chief of Schools

- Oversee and supervise school leaders and schools within the network
  - Building principal leadership, focusing on transforming schools resulting in a dramatic increase in student achievement.
  - Develop school leaders through principal network meetings (Cluster Model) and individual job embedded coaching
- Work with school leaders and their Instructional Leadership Teams (ILTs) to assess the needs of their schools through the analysis of implementation data and student outcomes (targeted Theory of Action and Action Plan)
- Work with school leaders to closely monitor school improvement and make adjustments accordingly

# Charge for the Chief of Schools

- Appropriately allocate network coaching resources to provide differentiated supports to the schools and monitor to assure effectiveness
- Coordinate with District staff to provide tools, services, and strategies for differentiated school-level supports for principals and Instructional Leadership Teams that drive school improvement
- Fostering meaningful relationships with families and community partners
- Management team administration and operations with the collaborative
- Develop communication and collaborative systems that insure smooth flow of information
